DECEMBER 2024 EXPENSES OVERVIEW

The relocation of elephants Eva and Lhamo, along with the entire SU4E team, took place on 10 December and was executed in an exceptionally well-organized and smooth manner. Thanks to thorough planning and the dedication of everyone involved, the walk to the new location unfolded without incident. Upon arrival, both the elephants and the team expressed clear signs of relief and happiness, marking the beginning of a new chapter in a more suitable and peaceful environment.



- Care and maintenance for elephants Eva and Lhamo.
- Continued feeding of Ramu with corn and hay until a stable long-term solution is established.

• Human-Elephant Conflict (HEC) Program:

- Conducting training sessions for villagers to prevent accidents with the wild elephant Makuna, who frequently enters human settlements.
- Supporting community efforts to safeguard both human lives and Makuna by mitigating risks of human misbehavior.

Relocation Preparations:

- Progress toward the move to Tiger Tops Tharu Lodge, scheduled for December 5th.
- Completion of temporary constructions for staff and elephants at the new site.
- Cost-saving measures, including repurposing materials from the Arnari facility, to minimize expenses while maintaining quality.
